



Voter Guides for State of New Mexico, Native American Communities

The League has released its first-ever all-county, statewide electronic voter guide. You can enter your address and see all state and local races, constitutional amendments, state bond issues and more. Voters throughout the state can see their election information at <https://www.lwvnm.org/VGuide2018>. All candidates received questions from the League, but as this was the first time, we did not experience a high rate of return.

Clicking on this link, <https://www.lwvnm.org/VGuide2018> will also take you to the Voter Guides published for the Native American communities in 12 counties. The Counties are: Bernalillo, Cibola, McKinley, Otero, San Juan, Rio Arriba, Sandoval, Santa Fe, Socorro, Luna, Taos and Valencia.

The League has printed 15,000 Voter Guides for these counties. Our volunteers and a generous grant from the Thornburg Foundation have made this possible. The Native American Voter Task Force is collaborating and will handle distribution throughout Indian Country. Give the short timeframe for this project, we were unable to include the candidate questionnaires in these guides, but plan to do so in the future. The guides will contain a listing of all candidates and ballot issues for those areas.
