Virtual Celebration and City Closures

Due to public health concerns, the City of Santa Fe will premier a Veteran's Day tribute video on 11:11 AM on Wednesday, November 11th on the City's Facebook page, thanking veterans from Santa Fe and across the nation for their service to our country. On Wednesday, November 11th, all virtual administrative offices, city libraries, the Municipal Court, and recreation centers will be closed. Trash and recycling collection services will operate on a regular schedule. Residential customers will need to have their recycling and solid waste placed at curbside by 7 a.m. Bus and trails service will operate on a Saturday schedule. The Santa Fe Public Library will be closed for Curbside Pickup and drop box returns. All library locations will open return drop boxes on Thursday, November 12th at 9 a.m. and Curbside Pickup will resume at noon on Thursday as well.
