

## GEORGIA U.S. SENATE RUNOFF ELECTIONS

**Albuquerque, January 6**—The following is a statement from Republican Party of New Mexico Chairman Steve Pearce after the Georgia runoff elections gave the Democratic Party control of the U.S. Senate:
