

Seeking Members for Mayor's Youth Advisory Board

Ages 13 to 21 Eligible to Serve

The City of Santa Fe is seeking to engage motivated young people who are eager to create change in their community. Youth ages 13 to 21 are encouraged to apply to serve on the Mayor's Youth Advisory Board (MYAB.)

The purpose of the Mayor's Youth Advisory Board is to provide input, suggestions, or recommendations to the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe pertaining to issues that affect youth in the community when deemed necessary and appropriate or upon request.

The Board shall consist of seven (7) members and three (3) alternate members, representing a diverse group of youth from the community. An alternate member may vote in the absence of a member. A non-voting City Councilor is appointed to the Board to provide support.

There are currently one (1) vacant board seat and three (3) alternate seats open. The board meets the third Thursday of every month from 5:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. (date and time are subject to change; meetings are held virtually until further notice.)
