



## REPUBLICAN PARTY OF NEW MEXICO TO SELECT ITS 1<sup>ST</sup> CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT NOMINEE ON MARCH 27

**Albuquerque, March 18**—The Republican Party of New Mexico announced today that its State Central Committee members from the 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District will elect the Party's Congressional nominee at a meeting on March 27 at 10am.

There are 135 voting members from the SCC CD-1 that will choose the nominee to run for the Congressional seat vacated by former Rep. Deb Haaland. The nominee will be elected by a plurality vote, and an independent election company will oversee the voting.

The election is a closed meeting as designated by RPNM state rules. RPNM cannot and will not endorse any candidate until after the election.
