



In order for New Mexico to retire its “Red to Green” framework and fully reopen by July 1, 60% of eligible New Mexicans will need to complete their vaccine series by June 17. Time is running out, and we need your help to ensure we meet our July 1 target on time. How can you help?

- **Schedule your Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine today.** If you still need to get vaccinated, consider asking for the Johnson & Johnson vaccine so you can complete your vaccine series in one shot, which will help keep New Mexico on track to reaching that 60% threshold by June 17.
