Engaging the public in redistricting is very important to us and to the process. We want to provide every opportunity possible for you to be a part of a fair redistricting for all New Mexicans. Please share this with your Albuquerque area contacts.

The Citizen Redistricting Committee (CRC) will host two sets of open forums, each with a unique purpose. The first set of seven public meetings is for the purpose of soliciting public input on what the CRC should consider when developing district maps. One of the major

considerations relates to Communities of Interest (COIs). [Click here](#) for an important explanation.

This is the time for you to make your voice heard! At [this website](#), you may submit written testimony, your own district plan*, or provide feedback on Communities of Interest. These may be submitted at any time through the first round of open forums.** You may also give your testimony orally and/or written at one of the CRC public meetings.

Once community input is received, the CRC will develop a series of draft maps. The second open forums, scheduled to occur between September 27 and October 8, 2021, are for the purpose of seeking the public's input on the Committee's proposed redistricting maps.

*Data from the current Census will be available **August 16**. That data will be fully uploaded to DistrictR (the mapping software preferred by the CRC) shortly thereafter. Maps created with the newest data would depict populations most accurately.

**The CRC has not yet announced a closing date for receiving public input.
