70% of New Mexicans 18+ have completed their COVID-19 vaccination series

SANTA FE - On Wednesday, the New Mexico Department of Health (DOH) announced that 70% of New Mexicans 18 years and older have completed their COVID-19 vaccination series.

“Almost three-quarters of New Mexico adults have now completed their vaccination series. Thank you to every New Mexican for getting your shots and protecting your community,” said DOH Deputy Secretary Dr. Laura Parajon.
