process when the Legislature meets in special session in early December where the CRC adopted maps will be considered.

We expect the Citizen Redistricting Committee to meet soon to review the map evaluations of Dr. David Cottrell, the analyst contracted to assess the CRC maps for fairness. The adopted maps, analysis, and commentary will then be sent to the legislature.
