- All WORKING media with a valid 2021-2022 NMAA Media Credential will be granted access to cover playoff games
- Because it is an outdoor event, face coverings are recommended but not required. Social distancing should be maintained to the greatest extent possible while covering the event and/or conducting interviews
- On-field access on the sidelines for media is limited to the area from the 10-yard line to the end line at the back of the end zone in all four corners of the field

(media are not allowed in the 80-yard area between the 10-yard lines on each side of the field) or behind the end lines

- Press Box access will be determined by the host site administration and may be limited/prohibited – if available, social distancing must be maintained and masks are required within these indoor spaces
- There will not be a “hospitality room”
