I-25 pavement rehabilitation project

LAS CRUCES - The New Mexico Department of Transportation District One office in cooperation with Mesa Verde Enterprises, Inc. (Contractor) is excited to announce the upcoming roadway reconstruction project on Interstate 25 from milepost 14 to 24, just north of Las Cruces.

Beginning Monday, Feb. 28, 2022, drivers can expect various daytime lane closures on both the northbound and southbound lanes as needed. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, if needed, some Saturdays. This reconstruction project was awarded in the amount of \$11 million and is expected to take 160 working days to complete.
