

## Aztec Boys & Girls Club is now Boys & Girls Club of San Juan County.

The support you have provided to the Aztec Boys & Girls Club over the past 10 year through our annual raffles and fundraisers has made an everlasting positive impact on generations of Aztec Boys & Girls Club kids. Those campaigns raised critical funds for the Club and provided families with a safe, nurturing environment for their kids during after-school and summer hours.

In 2022, Aztec Boys & Girls Club joined forces with Boys & Girls Club of Farmington for the 1st Annual Great Futures Ride. The fundraiser is a collective effort between the two organizations to become the premier 1-day riding event in the Four Corners to raise enough funds to cover 100% of our scholarship needs to ensure a family/kid is never turned away. The Great Futures Ride also included a motorcycle raffle that which is given away live at the event. In the first 2 years we saw 300+ participants support this worthy fundraising event raising more than \$73,000 for the Scholarship Program.

Uniting under a common mission, to inspire and enable all youth, especially those who need us the most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, and responsible adults, we have now become Boys & Girls Clubs of San Juan County. As the premier Out-of-School Time (OST) organization in San Juan County and a critical safety net for families, Boys & Girls Clubs of San Juan County (BGCSJC) has served youth with intentionality and purpose since 1960. BGCSJC provides a clear and consistent vision of youth development across the three communities while leveraging Club leadership and community resources. With the joining of communities, the Club has increased our membership, enhanced our programs, and offered greater opportunities for our youth to thrive while reducing the overall cost per child to provide these services.

With the combining of the two organizations, it only made sense to combine the two motorcycle raffles into 1 raffle with a clear and critical purpose. You will

also note the ticket price for the raffle has been reduced to \$20 per ticket with volume discounts for additional entries. With this information we are proud to invite you to continue your critical support by introducing you to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Great Futures Ride Street & Dirt.

The 3rd Annual Great Futures Ride Street & Dirt will be held on Saturday, October 12, 2024. The event includes 2 poker runs, 1 - Street (motorcycles & vehicles) 1 - Dirt (OHV's & UTV's). The Street Poker Run takes riders to all 3 San Juan County Clubs and the Dirt run takes the participants on the beautiful trails of the Glade OHV Area. Both groups meet back at Fun Center/Four Corners Indian Motorcycle for lunch, live music, beer & wine garden, table raffles & shenanigans. We conclude the day by drawing the winners of two great raffle prizes: a 2024 Indian Chieftan Dark Horse and a 2024 Polaris RZR XP 1000 4 Sport with a 16' Top Hat Trailer.
