“The Census is critical to funding for hospitals, schools, roads infrastructure, and programs we all rely on, but New Mexico has been undercounted in the past. It’s going to take all of us working together to make sure New Mexico gets its fair share of resources for our families,” **said Congresswoman Deb Haaland.**
