## **Lohman Avenue ADA Safety Improvements**

A-Mountain Construction (Contractor) will begin replacing the curb ramps in accordance with Public Right-of Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG) on June 1, 2021 at Lohman Ave over Interstate 25.

To expedite construction with minimal impact to traffic, improvements will be made overnight from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. The turning lanes to the on/off ramps will be reduced to one lane during construction. This project is scheduled to take two nights to complete, working from the west side then moving to the east side.
