NEW MEXICO MILITARY MUSEUM TO REOPEN WITH NAVY WEEK AND CIVIL WAR EVENTS

SANTA FE, N.M. – The New Mexico Military Museum will reopen to the public on Nov. 8, 2021. The museum closed temporarily to comply with COVID-19 restrictions and for renovations.

Operating hours are Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. The museum will be open on Veterans Day (Nov. 11) but will be closed on Friday, Nov. 12.

The Naval History and Heritage Command will host a display at the New Mexico Military Museum Nov. 9-11 for Navy Week. This event will include giveaways as well as provide resources for individual research.

The Museum will also host presenters Dr. Bob Mallin and Command Historian Florian Watil Nov. 10 to discuss Civil War era medicine and Waitl will share his work on virtual terrain modeling of historic Civil War sites in New Mexico. These presentations will complement the museum's new exhibit, New Mexico's Civil War, an interactive display that features key individuals, locations, and major events of the war in the New Mexico Territory. Doors open at 5:30 p.m., and the presentation begins at 6:00 p.m. Refreshments will be served.

All events are free to the public, but donations are welcome. The museum is located at 1050 Old Pecos Trail, Santa Fe, NM 87505.
