LAS CRUCES – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District One along with Highland Enterprises Inc. (Contractor) will begin litter cleanup efforts in Dona Ana County.

Beginning Monday, April 18, 2022, crews will assist the NMDOT with litter collection along I-25 near Lasburg and will be working south towards Las Cruces. Crews will be working in 5 mile stretches Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Help keep our crews safe, give them a brake, reduce your speed, and move over for emergency flashers.
