## National Guard members in wildfire response adopt rescued puppies

SANTA FE, N.M. – New Mexico National Guard members responding to the Calf Canyon/Hermits Peak fire have taken their support to another level.

The National Guard members adopted five of seven puppies rescued from the fire earlier this week.

Aaron Abeyta, an Espanola firefighter rescued seven puppies that approached him as he worked.

Española Humane staff received the puppies and provided vaccinations and microchips before making them available for adoption.

Guard personnel supporting the wildfire fight promptly adopted five of the seven dogs. Española Humane waived the adoption fees for the Guard members.
