



## Trail Closures and Fire Restrictions Extended

*Select Trails Remain Closed through June 17  
Fire and Fireworks Restrictions Extended through July 10*

SANTA FE, June 9, 2022 — Last evening the Governing Body adopted two resolutions to address ongoing extreme fire conditions in the City of Santa Fe and its environs:

- The trail closures and limitations on using grills in City parks ordered in Mayor Webber's Emergency Proclamation Responding to Fire Risks, issued on June 7, 2022, are extended to June 17, 2022.
- A Resolution banning certain fires and fireworks is extended through July 10. The restrictions were initially implemented in March. On June 29, the Governing Body will consider extending the further restrictions effective July 11 through August 9.

The extreme fire conditions that prompted the initial fire restrictions, including trail closures, on May 28 persist, as do the dangers of range fires, grass fires, forest fires, and structure fires in and around the city of Santa Fe. Residents are urged to abide by the closures and to utilize the City's robust network of inner-city trails, open spaces, parks, and recreation centers that remain open. **Details of closures and restrictions can be found below.**
