

UPDATE: MIDTOWN MOVING FORWARD

City Presents Proposed Land Use and Zoning Plans for Midtown Development

SANTA FE, July 14, 2022 – At the Midtown Early Neighborhood Notification (ENN) meeting last evening, members of the City’s Midtown redevelopment team presented to the public the proposed plan for the land uses and infrastructure framework that will enable development and investment at the site.

The meeting included an hour-long question-and-answer period for community members. Responses to written questions posed during the session will be posted at MidtownDistrictSantaFe.com as soon as possible, perhaps next week.

The Master Plan is scheduled for presentations to the Planning Commission (October 6) and the Governing Body (October 26).
