Ramp closures expected for I-25

LAS CRUCES - The New Mexico Department of Transportation District One office in cooperation with Mesa Verde Enterprises, Inc. (Contractor) will be continuing a roadway reconstruction project on Interstate 25 from milepost 14 to 24, just north of Las Cruces.

Thursday, August 4, and Friday, August 5, 2022, drivers can expect the northbound on/off ramps at exit 19, Radium Springs, to be closed for paving operations. NM 185 can be utilized as a detour route. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
