

Public Meeting for Sheridan Downtown Transit Center Improvements

5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 15, at Santa Fe Convention Center

The City of Santa Fe Public Works Department invites community members to attend a public meeting to review, comment, and provide feedback on the planning for the Sheridan Downtown Transit Center at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 15, in the Milagro and Kearny rooms at the [Santa Fe Convention Center \(201 W. Marcy St.\)](#).



The Sheridan Transit Center is utilized by locals and tourists alike, and is the downtown hub for pick-up and drop-off for bus riders on both the Santa Fe Trails and North Central Regional Transit District buses. It is also the drop-off point for Rail Runner and Santa Fe Plaza Pick-Up riders. The City applied for a Federal Highway Administration grant to support a redesign to upgrade the center's appearance and usability.

The improvements will include bus lane realignment and Sheridan Street repaving, sidewalk area widening, new brick-paved walkways, tree and tree well installations with steel grates in the sidewalk area, new bus shelters, and removal of the existing electronic information kiosk.
