

Traffic Report for week of January 8th to 15th, 2023.

In all construction zones, motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, as well as continue to be cautious of heavy equipment and construction personnel in the area. **PLEASE NOTE:** Conditions are subject to change without notice. Interstates:

Date St Business Loop Roundabout Project, T or C

La Calerita Construction, LLC. (Contractor) begins construction on Date Steet **Monday, Jan. 9th**. Phase 1 is expected to last about 2 (two) months, through early March 2023, the following traffic impacts will be in place:

Traffic on North Date Street will be reduced to one lane each direction (northbound and southbound) and will be shifted to the west (southbound) lanes from north of New School Road to Ash Street. **Local traffic on Smith Street** will be detoured to 9th Street. **Local traffic on New School Road** will be detoured to Barton St. Motorists are encouraged to use extra caution in the construction zone, obey lower posted speed limits and allow extra time to reach their destinations. Regular work hours will be 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday-Friday although the contractor may work longer hours or on weekends as needed.

I-10, Mile Marker 75 to 84, Deming

Mountain States Constructors, Inc. (Contractor) has completed the roadway rehabilitation project on Interstate 10 from milepost 75 (6 miles west of Deming) to milepost 84 (Deming). San Bar is still on-site replacing guardrail and barrier wall throughout the project. Drivers can expect various daytime lane closures on both the eastbound and westbound lanes as needed. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday.

I-25, Mile Marker 14 to 24, North of Las Cruces [CN1101610](#)

Mesa Verde Enterprises, Inc. (Contractor) has completed the roadway reconstruction project on Interstate 25 from milepost 14 to 24, just North of Las Cruces. San Bar is still on-site replacing guardrail and barrier wall throughout the project. Drivers can expect various daytime lane closures on both the northbound and southbound lanes as needed. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday.

I-25, Mile Marker 117 & 121, North of Truth or Consequences [CN1101580](#)

Hasse Contracting Co. (Contractor) this project is on winter suspension, contractor is expected to be back March 2023.

US Roadways:

NM 404 Roadway Widening, Anthony to Chaparral

Mountain States Constructors, Inc. (Contractor), starting Monday, January 9, 2023, will begin the roadway reconstruction and lighting project on NM 404 from milepost 0.9 (Anthony) to milepost 8.8 (Chaparral). Drivers can expect various daytime lane closures on both the eastbound and westbound lanes as needed. The contractor will begin building the eastbound lanes first moving then to the westbound lanes and finally into the median. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

NM 549, Mile Marker 0 and 18, Deming

Mountain States Constructors, Inc. (Contractor) will be resuming the roadway rehabilitation project on NM 549 from milepost 5.5 to milepost 18 (Akela). Beginning Monday, January 9, 2023, drivers can expect lane closures on both the eastbound and westbound lanes of NM 549 as needed. A pilot car operation will be in place, please reduce your speed and obey traffic control devices. Roadway will be restricted to 12-foot for oversized loads. Contractor's hours of operation will be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday with the possibility of some weekend work.

NM 169, Mile Marker 28.58, Alamo

Hasse Contracting Co. (Contractor) will be continuing bridge repairs on NM 169 near milepost 28.58. There is no impact to traffic, and only shoulder work signage in place. Contractors working hours are Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Construction is estimated to be in place till February 2023.

NM 404 and I-10 Bridge Replacement, Anthony RI00202

AUI, Inc. (Contractor) is continuing with roadwork and replacement of the NM 404 Bridge over I-10 at milepost 162, Anthony exit. Traffic is currently using new bridge as the contractor constructs the other half of the bridge. Daily contractor hours of operation are from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Traffic control will remain in place 24/7.

Frontage Road 1035 "Stern Drive" Mile Marker 5 to 6, Las Cruces

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will have lane closures and shoulder work in place for erosion control measures along Stern Dr. from milepost 5 to 6. A flagging operation will be in place. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and be cautious of personnel and equipment in the area.

Chip Seal Projects, Hidalgo Co:

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) has completed "Chip Sealing and Brooming" operations in Hidalgo Co. Speed limits will be reduced, no center stripe with loose gravel on roadway. Roadways listed below are scheduled for striping operations in 2023.

City of Las Cruces Projects:

Sonoma Ranch Boulevard

As part of the Sonoma Ranch Boulevard Mile 1 Construction Project, shoulder work is scheduled on Sonoma Ranch Boulevard, between Sierra Ventana Avenue and Peachtree Hills Road. The shoulder work is expected to last through approximately January 27, 2023. Additionally, a temporary roundabout is in place at the intersection of Sonoma Ranch Boulevard and Engler Road. Motorists are urged to obey all placed warning signs.

Sonoma Ranch Boulevard

As part of the Sonoma Ranch Boulevard Mile 3 Construction Project, work is scheduled to undergo with roadway and utility improvements by Caliper Construction, LLC on Sonoma Ranch Boulevard, between Arroyo Road and Paseo Verde. Work is estimated to last through approximately February 24, 2023.

Walnut Street

As part of the Bike-Pedestrian Infrastructure Improvements Project, work is scheduled to undergo with roadway and utility improvements by Highland Enterprises on Walnut Street, between Hadley and Spruce. Alternating lane shifts will be in place. Work is estimated to last through approximately April 30, 2023.
