## **NMPRC to hold public comment hearing regarding PNM's application for revision of rates**

SANTA FE — The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (NMPRC) will hold a hearing to collect oral comments from members of the public regarding case no. 22-00270-UT, In the Matter of the Application of Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM) for Revision of its Retail Rates. Anyone who is not affiliated with a party in this case may make oral comment in person or via the Zoom app or by telephone. This public comment hearing will be held in person and accessible to watch online via YouTube.

Please keep in mind that public comment is not evidence.
