This year's jury will select prize-winning work that best reflects the themes from [2024 Santa Fe Read's](#) selected works.

Themes can include, but are not limited to:

- The Hero's Journey
- Finding One's Power
- Female Strength
- Greek Mythology

Prizes will be awarded in the following age categories: Toddler 0-4, Children 5-8, Youth 9-12, Teens 3-17, and Adult 18-plus.

All received entries will be exhibited at the Santa Fe Public Library downtown branch gallery space **(Work must be appropriate for a public setting for all ages)**.
